

2024 IMAGE BUILDERS SCHOLARSHIP

The Image Builders Scholarship was created by the NAIFA–Alabama (National Association of Insurance and Financial Advisors of Alabama) Board of Directors to provide a higher education scholarship to an undergraduate student who demonstrates exceptional academic performance and/or significant financial need. Eligible students may not be receiving a full-tuition scholarship or waiver from another source.

The Image Builders Scholarship is intended to help propel the values and interests of NAIFA-Alabama by establishing a socially responsible medium which exists solely to compliment NAIFA-Alabama in promoting and advancing the aims and ideals of the Association and its members. NAIFA-Alabama is committed to protecting the integrity of the business of insurance and the best interests of the citizens of Alabama. It is our desire to serve our constituents by becoming involved in improving the educational welfare of this great state. It is in this spirit that the Board of Directors of NAIFA-Alabama has established the Image Builders Scholarship.

An advocate for insurance agents, financial advisors and consumers, NAIFA was founded on June 18, 1890, in Boston as the National Association of Life Underwriters (NALU). NAIFA-Alabama was established in 1937 as the Alabama Association of Life Underwriters and in June 2008 our name was changed to NAIFA-Alabama. The National Association of Insurance and Financial Advisors (NAIFA) is a national nonprofit association representing the interests of more than 70,000 insurance and financial advisors nationwide through its federation of over 900 state and local associations. As the nation's largest financial services membership association, NAIFA plays a vital role in encouraging legislation and regulation at the federal and state levels to protect consumers and maintain a healthy and well-regulated marketplace. NAIFA also provides its members with education, training, and sales resources to help them maintain and grow their practices.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

The following are eligibility requirements for qualifying an applicant for the Scholarship:

- 1. Applicant must be resident of the State of Alabama.
- 2. Applicant must be a graduating senior from a high school in Alabama.
- 3. Applicant must be accepted into an accredited college or university.
- 4. Grade Point Average must be 2.5 or higher on a 4.0 scale.
- Recipient will be chosen by the Scholarship Committee, Confirmed by the Board of Directors.
- 6. Application package must be received no later than Friday, March 15, 2024 to be considered.
- 7. Checks will be made payable to the University in your name.
